Responsibilities:

Read & comprehend building plans for roof & ground mounted arrays.

Assemble and install the solar array racking, feet, modules and inverters. Properly seal all roof penetrations.

Carry and install solar panels, both ground and roof mounted.

Perform initial wiring and connections of panels to inverters.

Load and unload equipment from warehouse to jobsite, checking required materials.

Clean up jobsites at the end of each day.

Communicate with install team in a professional, considerate, and respectful manner, answering all questions and concerns to the best of your ability.

Electrical Work: Properly crimp MC4 ends, install home runs, bend EMT, inverter stringing, low voltage (Cat5) installation, DC Combiner box wiring, pipe runs, wire management etc.

General Construction work: using hand tools, measuring, leveling, assembling etc.

Other duties as assigned.

Must be 18 years old.

Must have a valid driver's license and clean driving record.

General construction knowledge to include: roofing, electrical, and carpentry skills. General ladder experience.
